





# Pattullo Bridge: Overnight Northbound Lane Closures

## May 14, 2024

Construction of the new bridge deck is ongoing in Surrey with crews lifting steel girders between the main bridge and offramp foundations just east of the existing Pattullo Bridge. On May 17, Fraser Crossing Partners will require an overnight closure of the Pattullo Bridge in the northbound direction due to the proximity of the girder installation equipment to the existing bridge in Surrey. An additional overnight closure on May 18 may be required. The closures are noted in the table below:

| Closure # | Closure Dates                  | Time            | Direction closed                                     |
|-----------|--------------------------------|-----------------|--|
| 1         | Friday, May 17                 | 9 p.m. – 5 a.m. | Pattullo Bridge Northbound (towards New Westminster) |
| 2         | Saturday, May 18 (if required) | 9 p.m. – 5 a.m. | Pattullo Bridge Northbound (towards New Westminster) |

Pattullo Bridge users going to New Westminster are encouraged to take the Port Mann or Alex Fraser bridges during the northbound lane closures. Northbound N19 NightBus trips will be rerouted over the Queensborough and Alex Fraser bridges, and affected customers should plan for an additional 30 minutes of travel time. Emergency vehicle access, and access for pedestrians and cyclists, will be maintained.

TransLink's single lane closure for southbound traffic (drivers travelling from New Westminster to Surrey) on the Pattullo Bridge will remain in effect and one southbound lane will remain open.
