



# Daytime underground utility work on Royal Avenue between Coburg Street and Dufferin Street

May 30, 2024

Starting Monday, June 3, crews will be installing underground utilities on Royal Avenue between Coburg Street and Dufferin Street. This work will take place between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. and will continue for approximately two weeks.

While this work is underway, one lane in each direction will be maintained on Royal Avenue between 1<sup>st</sup> Street and the Royal Avenue on-ramp. Occasionally, access to Coburg Street from Royal Avenue will be restricted. When it is restricted, eastbound drivers on Royal Avenue will be detoured at 1<sup>st</sup> Street. Westbound drivers on Royal Avenue will be detoured to 4<sup>th</sup> Street. Access to residences will be maintained at all times.

Pedestrians and cyclists will also be detoured around the work area. All traffic pattern changes will be well-signed and traffic control personnel will be on site to assist if and when required.

Excavation, saw cutting, and hydrovaccing activities are required as part of this work and periods of noise can be expected.

## What to Expect



### Timing

Starting Monday, June 3 and continuing for approximately two weeks.



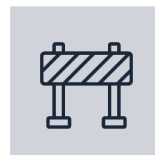
### Hours of Work

7 a.m. – 5 p.m.



### Traffic

Single lane closures on Royal Avenue between 1<sup>st</sup> Street and the Royal Avenue on-ramp will be required in be in place 24/7. Occasionally, access to Coburg Street from Royal Avenue will also be restricted during which detours will be in place. Traffic control personnel will be on site to assist if and when required, and all traffic pattern changes will be well-signed.



### Impacts/Interruptions

Local residents can expect periods of noise from the excavation, saw cutting, and hydrovaccing activities. We appreciate your patience while this work is underway.
