



Bridge deck construction and resumption of in-river works

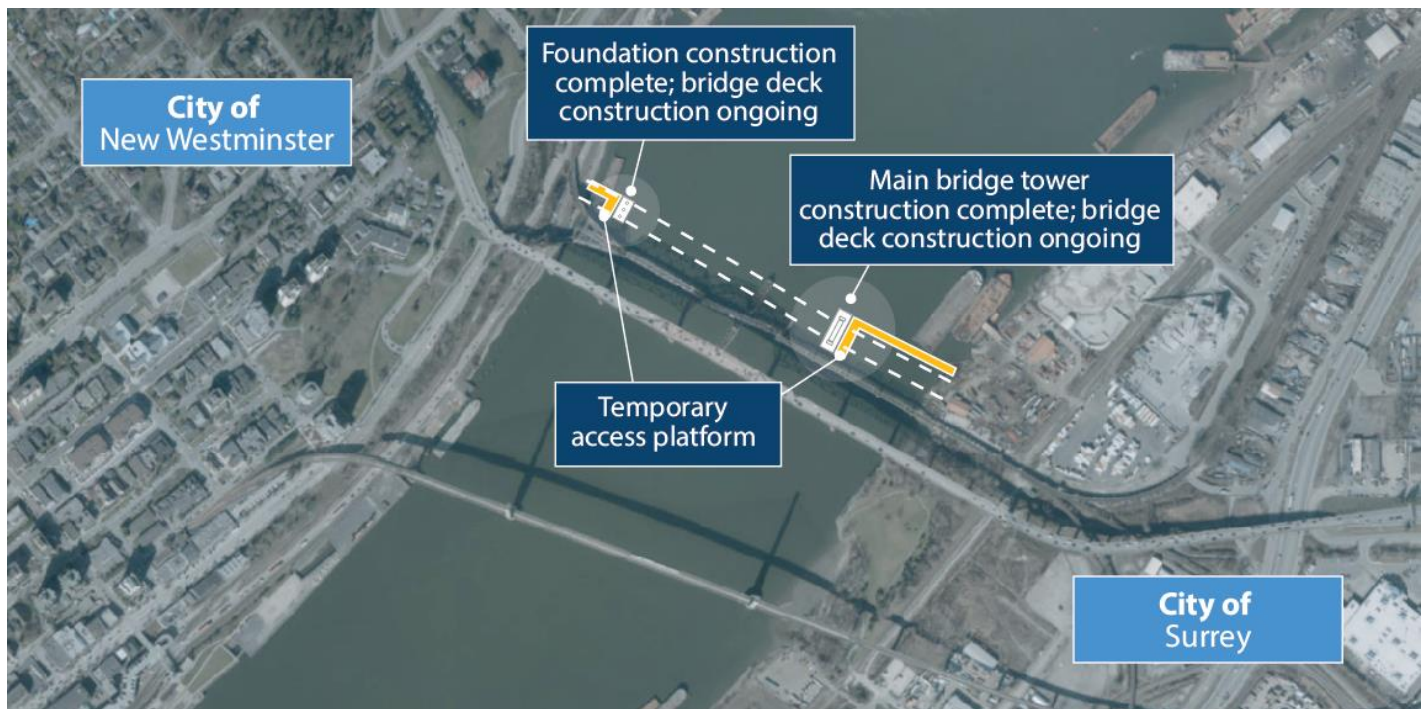

Construction of the Pattullo Bridge replacement is progressing with all of the on-land foundations, the bridge tower and bridge foundation near the New Westminster shoreline now complete.

Crews are now constructing the bridge deck across the Fraser River. To complete this work, gantry cranes on top of the bridge deck are being used to lift steel girders and concrete deck panels into place from above the Fraser River. While this method of construction significantly reduces interferences to marine navigation, occasional short-term restrictions of the navigation channels will be required to ensure public safety.

Intermittent restrictions will be communicated to marine users via weekly Navigational Warnings (NAVWARNs). NAVWARNs will also be posted on the Project website.

In the coming months, soil densification activities near the Surrey shoreline are expected to resume. The start date of this work is subject to river conditions and will be in accordance with Fisheries and Oceans Canada requirements for minimizing impact to fish and fish habitat.

What to Expect



Timing

Bridge deck construction is ongoing. In-river works will resume subject to river conditions and will be in accordance with Fisheries and Oceans Canada requirements.



Hours of Work

Monday to Friday from 7:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m.
Saturdays from 9:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m., and
some Sundays from 10:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.

Welding and other ancillary work on site will occur 24 hours a day, seven days a week.



Traffic

A full closure of Front Street is required while bridge deck construction is underway between the in-river foundation near the New Westminster shoreline and the foundation south of Columbia Street. For more information, including detours, please visit the Project website. Occasional short-term restrictions of the in-river navigation channels will be required.



Impacts/Interruptions

Nearby residents and businesses may hear some noise associated with bridge deck construction activities; however, the majority of activities will take place during the day.
