



Underground utility work on Agnes Street between Coburg Street and Dufferin Street

June 27, 2024

During the week of July 2, Fraser Crossing Partners will be conducting underground utility work on Agnes Street between Coburg Street and Dufferin Street. Traffic on Agnes Street will be shifted to create a work area for crews to perform the underground utility work which will include saw cutting, excavation and hydrovaccing.

One lane in each direction on Agnes Street will remain open and access to Coburg Street and Dufferin Street will be maintained at all times. While this work is underway, there will be temporary parking restrictions on Agnes Street between Coburg Street and Dufferin Street. Pedestrian and cyclist access will be maintained.

All traffic pattern changes and parking restrictions will be well-signed, and traffic control personnel will be on-site when required.

What to Expect



Timing

Starting July 2, 2024 and continuing for approximately ten days.



Hours of Work

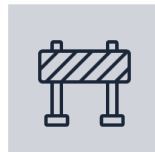
Monday to Friday from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m.

Lane shift and temporary parking restrictions will be in effect 24 hours a day.



Traffic

Traffic lanes on Agnes Street between Coburg Street and Dufferin Street will be shifted to create work space. Traffic control personnel will be on site to assist when required, and all traffic pattern changes will be well-signed.



Impacts/Interruptions

Nearby residents may hear noise from saw cutting, excavation, and hydrovaccing activities. Temporary parking restrictions will be in effect. We appreciate your patience while this work is underway.
