

Construction of the westbound portion of the new Highway 17 / Old Yale Road overpass

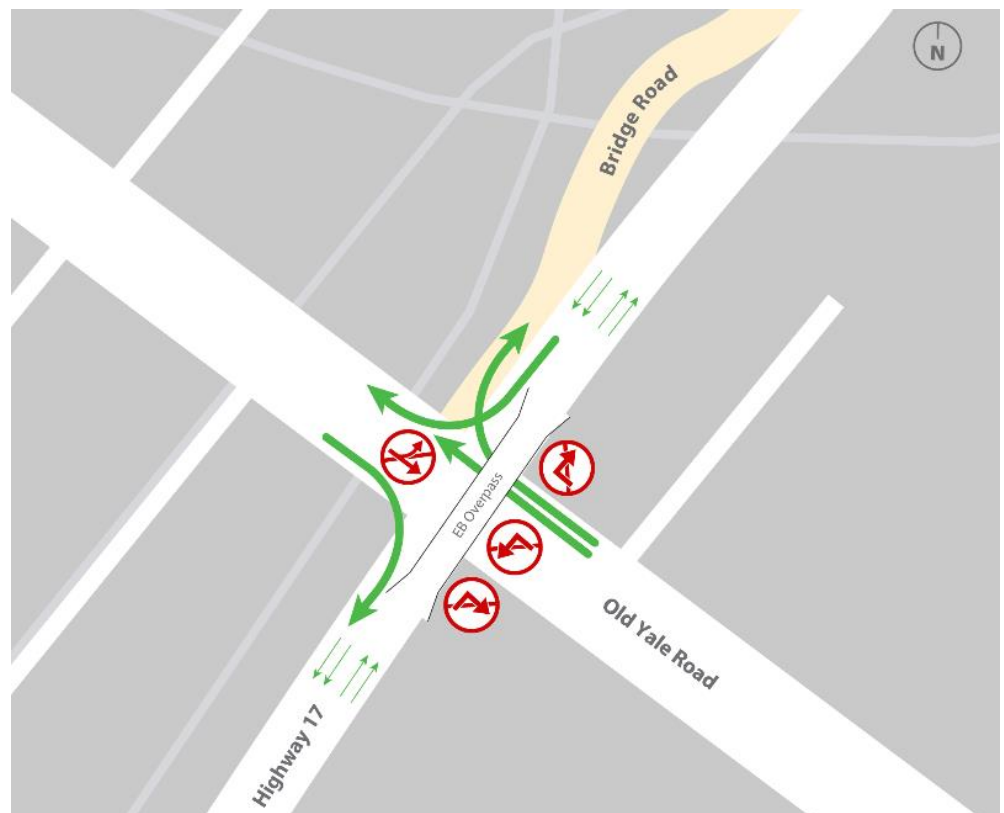
July 15, 2024

As part of the Pattullo Bridge Replacement Project, Highway 17 will be grade-separated over Old Yale Road, improving traffic flow on Highway 17. In late July/early August, Highway 17 eastbound traffic will be shifted onto the completed portion of the new overpass, and construction of the westbound portion will begin.

New traffic movements

- Permanent removal of access between Old Yale Road and Highway 17 eastbound
- Permanent removal of the left turn from Old Yale Road northbound to Highway 17 westbound
- Temporary six-month restriction of Old Yale Road southbound access across Highway 17

Permitted traffic movements are shown by the green arrows in the graphic to the right.

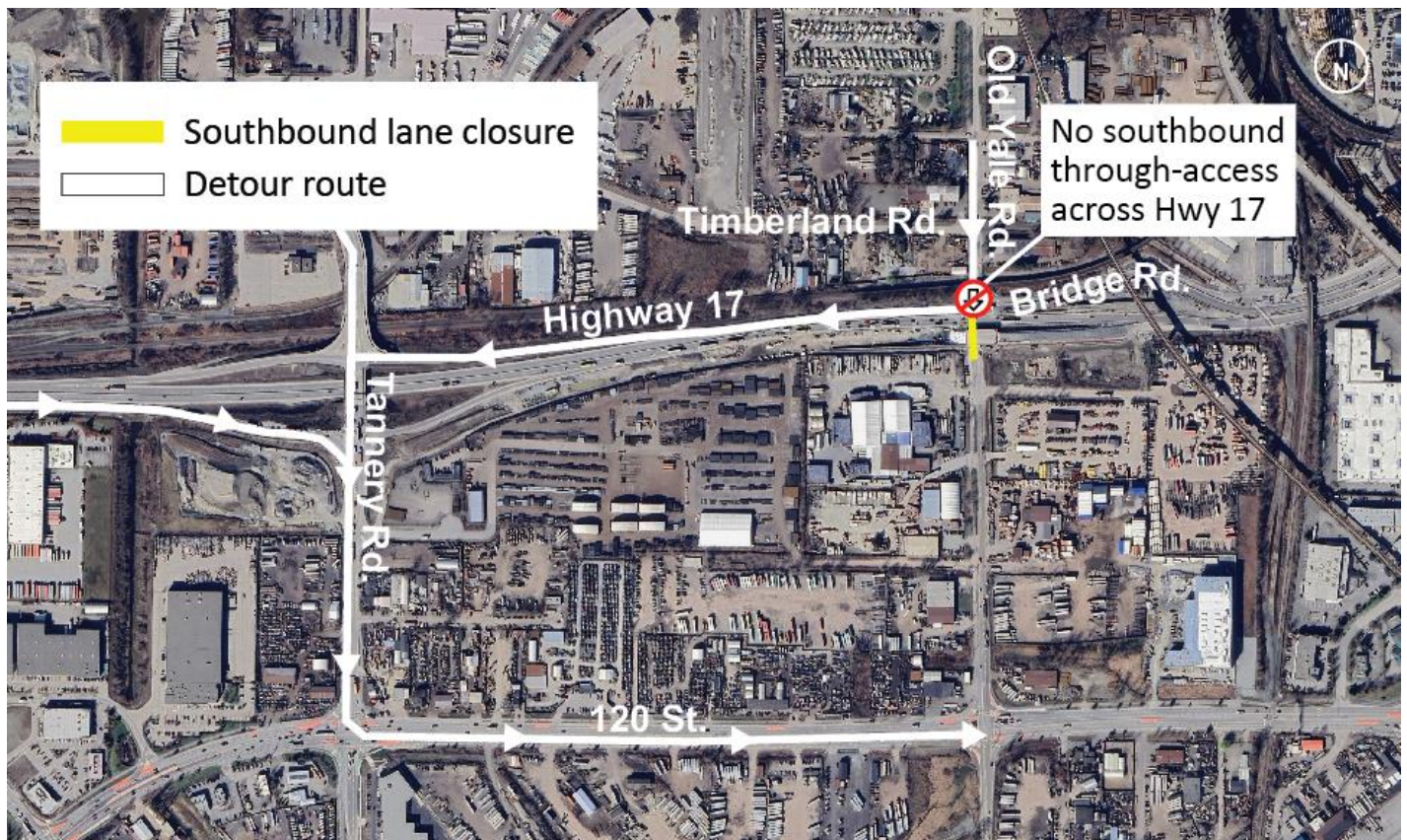

Overpass construction

Construction of the westbound portion of new overpass will involve intermittent pile driving activities Monday to Saturday between 7 a.m. and 10 p.m. for approximately six weeks. Once pile driving activities are complete, crews will build the foundations and overpass.

Traffic movements / detour

- **No southbound through access on Old Yale Road across Highway 17** for approximately six months. Drivers on Old Yale Road north of Highway 17 will be detoured to Tannery Road via Highway 17 westbound.
- **Northbound through access maintained on Old Yale Road across Highway 17.**
- Access maintained to Bridge Road. Occasional closures of Bridge Road will be required.
- Access maintained to and from the businesses on Old Yale Road north of Highway 17.
- Access maintained for pedestrian and cyclist access across Highway 17.

What to Expect



Timing

Late July/early August 2024 for approximately six months.



Hours of Work

Pile driving and ongoing construction activities will take place Monday to Saturday between 7 a.m. and 10 p.m.

As much as possible, noisy work activities will be completed during the day. Some non-noisy work activities will take place at night and on Sundays.



Traffic

The six-month restriction of Old Yale Road southbound across Highway 17 will remain in effect 24/7. Drivers will be detoured to Tannery Road via Highway 17 westbound. Occasional closures of Bridge Road will be required. When required, traffic control personnel will be on site and all traffic pattern changes will be well-signed.



Impacts/Interruptions

Drivers may experience longer than normal travel times due to the temporary detours. We appreciate your patience while this work is underway.
