





Pattullo Bridge: Overnight Northbound Lane Closures

July 16, 2024

Construction of the new bridge deck is ongoing in Surrey with crews lifting concrete deck panels on top of steel girders between the main bridge and off-ramp foundations just east of the existing Pattullo Bridge. On July 19, Fraser Crossing Partners will require an overnight closure of the Pattullo Bridge in the northbound direction due to the proximity of the equipment that is required to install deck panels to the existing bridge in Surrey. An additional overnight closure on July 20 may be required. The closures are noted in the table below:

Closure #	Closure Dates	Time	Direction closed
1	Friday, July 19	9 p.m. – 5 a.m.	Pattullo Bridge Northbound (towards New Westminster)
2	Saturday, July 20 (if required)	9 p.m. – 5 a.m.	Pattullo Bridge Northbound (towards New Westminster)

Pattullo Bridge users going to New Westminster are encouraged to take the Port Mann or Alex Fraser bridges during the northbound lane closures. Northbound N19 NightBus trips will be rerouted over the Queensborough and Alex Fraser bridges, and affected customers should plan for an additional 30 minutes of travel time. Emergency vehicle access, and access for pedestrians and cyclists, will be maintained.

TransLink's single lane closure for southbound traffic (drivers travelling from New Westminster to Surrey) on the Pattullo Bridge will remain in effect and one southbound lane will remain open.

Traffic

Overnight closures of the northbound lanes on the Pattullo Bridge. Detours will be required.



Impacts/Interruptions

Drivers and transit users may experience longer than normal travel times due to the northbound lane closures. Nearby residents may hear some noise associated with overnight work activities.
