





Ongoing construction on Agnes Street and Dufferin Street and permanent removal of a section of street parking

July 17, 2024

During the first two weeks of July, Fraser Crossing Partners completed underground utility work on Agnes Street between Coburg Street and Dufferin Street. Crews will continue with drainage work and curb installation in this area for the remainder of the month into August. Single lane alternating traffic on Agnes Street will be in place during work hours to create space for work areas. Access to Coburg Street and Dufferin Street will be maintained at all times.

While this work is underway, 24/7 temporary parking restrictions will be in effect on both sides of Agnes Street between Coburg Street and Dufferin Street.

Parking on the south side of Agnes Street between Coburg Street and Dufferin Street will be permanently removed immediately following this work as part of the reconfiguration of the roadway and overall improvements planned for this area.

All traffic pattern changes and parking restrictions will be well-signed, and traffic control personnel will be on-site when required. Pedestrian and cyclist access will be maintained.

Crews will also be conducting underground utility work on Dufferin Street at Royal Avenue. While this work is underway, pedestrian and cyclist access between Royal Avenue and Dufferin Street will be temporarily restricted. Pedestrians and cyclists will be detoured to Coburg Street.

What to Expect



Timing

Ongoing throughout July and into August



Hours of Work

Monday to Friday from 7 a.m. - 8 p.m.

Temporary parking restrictions will be in effect 24 hours a day.



Traffic

Single lane alternating traffic will be in place on Agnes Street between Coburg Street and Dufferin Street to create work space. Dufferin Street, between Agnes Street and Royal Avenue, will be open to residents only. Traffic control personnel will be on site to assist when required, and all traffic pattern changes will be well-signed.



Impacts/Interruptions

Nearby residents may hear noise from construction activities. Parking restrictions will also be in effect. We appreciate your patience while this work is underway.
