





Full closure of 112/111a Avenue

July 19, 2024

From 7 p.m. Friday, July 26 until 5 a.m. Sunday, July 28, 112/111a Avenue will be closed for work related to the Pattullo Bridge Replacement Project.

On Saturday, July 27, 112/111a Avenue will be closed to facilitate underground and overhead electrical work being conducted by BC Hydro. This work will involve a service outage to local power, and access to business fronts will not be maintained while this work is underway.

A full closure of 112/111a Avenue will also be in effect at night on Friday, July 26 and Saturday, July 27 for crews to continue with ongoing deck panel installation activities. When deck panel installation work is underway, access to businesses will be maintained.

During the full closure, the 371 bus stop on 111a Ave will be closed. Please check the TransLink Trip Planner for more information and updated schedules.

All traffic pattern changes will be well-signed, and traffic control personnel will be on-site when required to assist pedestrians, cyclists, and vehicles with turnaround.

Hours of Work

Electrical work will take place between 5 a.m. and 7 p.m. on Saturday, July 27.

Deck panel installation will take place between 7 p.m. and 5 a.m. on the night of Friday, July 26 into the morning of Saturday, July 27, and on the night of Saturday, July 27 into the morning of Sunday, July 28.



Traffic

A full closure of 112/111a Avenue will be required. Traffic control personnel will be on site to assist when required, and all traffic pattern changes will be well-signed.



Impacts/Interruptions

Access to business fronts will not be maintained on Saturday, July 27. BC Hydro will be implementing a service outage to local power. We appreciate your patience while this work is underway.
