

# Weekend closure of Highway 17 eastbound between Tannery Road and Bridgeview Drive

July 22, 2024

As part of the Pattullo Bridge Replacement Project, Highway 17 will be grade-separated over Old Yale Road, improving traffic flow on Highway 17. Construction of the eastbound portion of the new Old Yale Road overpass is nearly complete.

From Friday, July 26 at 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. on Monday, July 29, Highway 17 eastbound will be closed between Tannery Road and Bridgeview Drive for crews to complete the necessary roadwork before opening the eastbound portion of the new Old Yale Road overpass.

During the closure, drivers travelling eastbound on Highway 17 will be detoured at Tannery Road to travel on 120 Street, King George Boulevard, and Bridgeview Drive to continue on Highway 17.



Old Yale Road will remain open to local traffic only between Highway 17 and 120 Street. Road signage will be in place and detour routes will be clearly marked (as shown above). Cyclists and emergency responders will need to follow detour routes while these closures are in effect.

Highway 17 eastbound traffic will shift onto the completed portion of the new Old Yale Road overpass as of 5 a.m. on Monday, July 29. At this time, all turning movements between Old Yale Road and Highway 17 eastbound will be permanently removed and crews will begin construction of the westbound portion of new Old Yale Road overpass. Additionally, as part of the final project configuration, the Old Yale Road northbound left turn to Highway 17 westbound will be permanently removed.

### Timing

July 26-29, 2024



### Hours of Work

From 9 p.m. Friday, July 26 until 5 a.m. on Monday, July 29.

Work will take place 24 hours a day. As much as possible, noisy work activities will be completed during the day.



### Traffic

Highway 17 eastbound drivers will be detoured at Tannery Road to travel on 120 Street, King George Boulevard, and Bridgeview Drive to continue on Highway 17. Old Yale Road will remain open to local traffic only between Highway 17 and 120 Street. Traffic control personnel will be on site to direct traffic when stoppages are required. All traffic pattern changes and detour routes will be well signed.



### Impacts/Interruptions

Drivers may experience longer than normal travel times due to the detour. Nearby residents and businesses may hear noise associated with the roadwork. We appreciate your patience while this work is underway.
