



Investigative works in Brownsville Bar Park and under the existing Pattullo Bridge

August 2, 2024

Starting in August 2024, Fraser Crossing Partners (FCP) will be conducting additional investigative works within Brownsville Bar Park and along the existing bridge corridor. This work will take place intermittently for the remainder of 2024.

While this work is underway, crews will drill boreholes using a small excavator fitted with an auger drill to gather subsurface soil information. Visual surveys as part of environmental studies will also be completed within the area.

Pedestrian access to and within the park will be maintained at all times.

This work is required to inform plans for temporary access and placement of heavy equipment that will support the removal of the existing Pattullo Bridge once the new bridge is open.

Timing

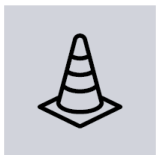
Starting in August and continuing intermittently for the remainder of 2024.



Hours of Work

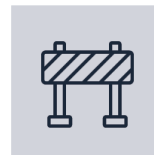
Monday to Saturday from 7:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m.

Traffic

Nearby businesses, residents, and pedestrians may notice construction vehicles and equipment accessing Brownsville Bar Park via Old Yale Road. Traffic control personnel will be onsite to assist if necessary.



Impacts/Interruptions

Within each investigative area, workers will be operating a small excavator fitted with an auger drill which will produce intermittent noise.
