





Upcoming roadworks on 112 Avenue

September 5, 2024

Starting Wednesday, September 11, Fraser Crossing Partners will begin building driveways for businesses and installing curbs and gutters along the east side of 112 Avenue (in front of the businesses). Crews will also build a new sidewalk as part of the overall improvements for this area. This work is expected to take approximately three weeks to complete; however, it is weather dependent. Temporary no parking will be in effect on both sides of 112 Avenue while this work is underway.

Driveway construction will be done over two weekends to ensure that access to businesses is maintained at all times. The first section of each driveway will be completed the weekend of September 13 and the remaining section of driveway will be completed the following weekend (September 20).

In late September, 112 Avenue will also be paved, which may require nighttime 112 Avenue full closures between 7:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. Details will be posted to the top of the <u>Current Works page</u> on the Project website once dates are confirmed.

Once this work is complete, the temporary traffic signals that are currently in place on 112 Avenue will be removed and the roadway will be restored to two-way traffic. A number of other upgrades will also be made in this area including improved pedestrian and cyclist access, the addition of parallel parking on both sides of the street, and the installation of new streetlights and landscaping. More information will be provided in advance.

Single lane alternating traffic will remain in effect to maintain traffic flow and traffic control personnel will be on site to direct traffic, pedestrians, and cyclists as required.

What to Expect



Timing

Starting Wednesday, September 11 and continuing for approximately three weeks. As some of this work is weather dependent, the exact dates will be confirmed via signage.



Hours of Work

Monday to Saturday from 7:00 a.m. - 10:00 p.m.

General construction activities will occur 24 hours a day, seven days a week.



Traffic

Single lane alternating traffic will remain in effect until the temporary traffic signals are removed. Traffic control personnel will be on site to direct traffic, pedestrians, and cyclists as required.



Impacts/Interruptions

Nearby businesses will hear some noise from crews and equipment while roadworks are underway. Temporary no parking will be in effect on both sides of 112 Avenue while this work is underway. Drivers may experience short temporary delays resulting from the temporary traffic signals.
