



Underground utility work on King George Boulevard between Scott Road and 128 Street

September 18, 2024

Starting on Thursday, September 19, Fraser Crossing Partners will be conducting underground utility work on King George Boulevard between Scott Road and 128 Street as part of the Pattullo Bridge Replacement Project. This work will continue for approximately six weeks.

The majority of this work will be completed during the day between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m.; however, some nightshift work will also be required between the hours of 8 p.m. and 5 a.m. Construction activities such as excavation, saw cutting, backfilling, and road paving are required and may result in periods of noise. Noisy works will be completed as early in the evenings as possible.

Sections of temporary no parking will also be in effect along King George Boulevard for the duration of this work. Access to businesses will be maintained at all times.

Starting on Thursday, September 19 and continuing for approximately six weeks.



Hours of Work

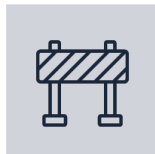
Monday to Saturday from 7:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m.
