Finishing Touches

Once the main bridge structure and roadway connections have been completed, there are lots of finishing touches that will be added to improve safety, reduce noise, and beautify the project site.



Fencing – in addition to barriers, bike and sidewalk fence will be added along certain roads and pathways to increase separation from traffic.



Line painting – lane markings will be painted on roads and pathways to show people where to drive, walk, cycle and roll.



Signage – signs will be added to help pedestrians and vehicles find their way and safely navigate the new roads and pathways.





Lighting – lighting will be added along roads and pathways to improve safety and help people see their way at night.



Noise walls – walls will be installed between certain traffic lanes and residential areas, to help reduce noise.



Landscaping – many different native species of plants and trees will be planted throughout the project site to make it more beautiful.



Urban nodes – the project includes areas with amenities for people who are walking, cycling or rolling, called urban nodes. The nodes will be places to stop and enjoy, with benches, lighting, drinking fountains, bike racks, and landscaping.
