





Nighttime utility and road work on Bridge Connector

October 3, 2024

On Monday, October 7, Fraser Crossing Partners will be conducting nighttime utility and road work on Bridge Connector and a section of McBride Boulevard north of Royal Avenue. On Wednesday, October 9, crews will be replacing streetlights along the Royal Avenue off-ramp.

This work will be concurrent with TransLink's closures of the Pattullo Bridge to minimize impacts to drivers and nearby residents. Please refer to TransLink's website for more information about the closures.

Construction activities such as excavation, backfilling, and road paving are required while work is underway and may result in periods of noise. A small amount of saw cutting will also be required on the night of Monday, October 7 and will be completed as quickly and as early in the evening as possible.

Traffic

Nighttime lane closures on Bridge Connector. Access from 3rd Ave to southbound McBride Boulevard will be closed. Access to the Royal Avenue off-ramps and to Memorial Drive will be maintained. Traffic control personnel will be on site to assist when required, and all traffic pattern changes will be well-signed.



Impacts/Interruptions

Nearby residents may hear noise from saw cutting, as well as heavy equipment used for road work. Saw cutting will be done as soon as the road closure has been implemented and will be completed as quickly as possible. We appreciate your patience while this work is underway.
