



Ongoing road work and wall construction on 112 Avenue

October 4, 2024

In late September, Fraser Crossing Partners graded and paved 112 Avenue. 112 Avenue has now been reopened to two-way traffic. Construction of the curbs, driveways, and new sidewalk on the east side of 112 Avenue (in front of the businesses) is ongoing.

Construction of a retaining wall and embankment on the west side of 112 Avenue (adjacent to King George Boulevard) is also now underway. This work will continue for approximately three months. While this work is underway, temporary no parking will be in effect along the west side of 112 Avenue, and intermittent single lane alternating traffic will be required.

Once construction of the retaining wall and embankment is complete, a number of other upgrades will be made in this area. These include a new multi-use pathway improving pedestrian and cyclist access to and from the new bridge and throughout the area, the addition of parallel parking on both sides of the street, and the installation of new streetlights and landscaping. More information will be provided in advance.

What to Expect



Timing

Construction of the retaining wall and embankment will be ongoing for approximately three months.



Hours of Work

The majority of work will be performed between Monday to Saturday from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.

Some nighttime work may be required. As much as possible, noisy work activities will be completed during the day.



Traffic

Occasional lane shifts and single lane alternating traffic will be required while construction activities are underway. Traffic control personnel will be on site to direct traffic, pedestrians, and cyclists as required.



Impacts/Interruptions

Nearby businesses will hear some noise from crews and equipment while construction activities are underway. Temporary no parking will be in effect on the west side of 112 Avenue while this work is underway.
