



Nighttime single lane alternating traffic on Columbia Street

October 30, 2024

During the week of November 4, Fraser Crossing Partners will be installing panels for the retaining wall on the south side of Columbia Street, just west of McBride Boulevard, as part of construction of the new E. Columbia Street off-ramp. This work will take approximately three nights to complete.

While this work is underway, single lane alternating traffic will be in effect at night on Columbia Street between McBride Boulevard and the existing Pattullo Bridge to provide crews with space for a crane required to complete the work. The McBride Boulevard and Columbia Street intersection will be controlled by traffic control personnel.

This work is being conducted at night to minimize disruption to traffic and is not anticipated to be noisy.

During the week of November 4, there will be approximately three nights of work.



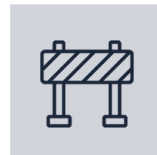
Hours of Work

Traffic

Single lane alternating traffic will be in effect on Columbia Street between McBride Boulevard and the existing Pattullo Bridge. Traffic control personnel will be on site to direct traffic, pedestrians, and cyclists. All traffic pattern changes will be well signed.

Drivers may experience longer than normal travel times due to lane closures.
