



Underground utility work on McBride Boulevard

November 27, 2024

On Saturday, November 30, Fraser Crossing Partners will be conducting daytime utility work on the east side of McBride Boulevard between E. Columbia Street and Royal Avenue. This work includes relocating a fire hydrant which will require the removal of some vegetation adjacent to the sidewalk.

While this work is underway, there will be a single northbound lane closure on McBride Boulevard and the sidewalk on the east side of the road will be temporarily closed. Pedestrians and cyclists will be detoured to the west sidewalk and detour routes will be clearly marked.

Construction activities such as excavation, saw cutting, and backfilling are required to complete this work and may result in periods of noise. A small amount of hydrovaccing will also be required.

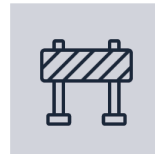
Hours of Work

One northbound lane on McBride Boulevard will remain open while this work is underway. Traffic control personnel will be on site to assist drivers, pedestrians, and cyclists. All traffic pattern changes will be well-signed.

Nearby residents may hear noise from saw cutting, hydrovaccing, and heavy equipment. This work is being completed during the day to avoid nighttime noise. We appreciate your patience while this work is underway.
