



# UPDATED: Full closure of Front Street extended

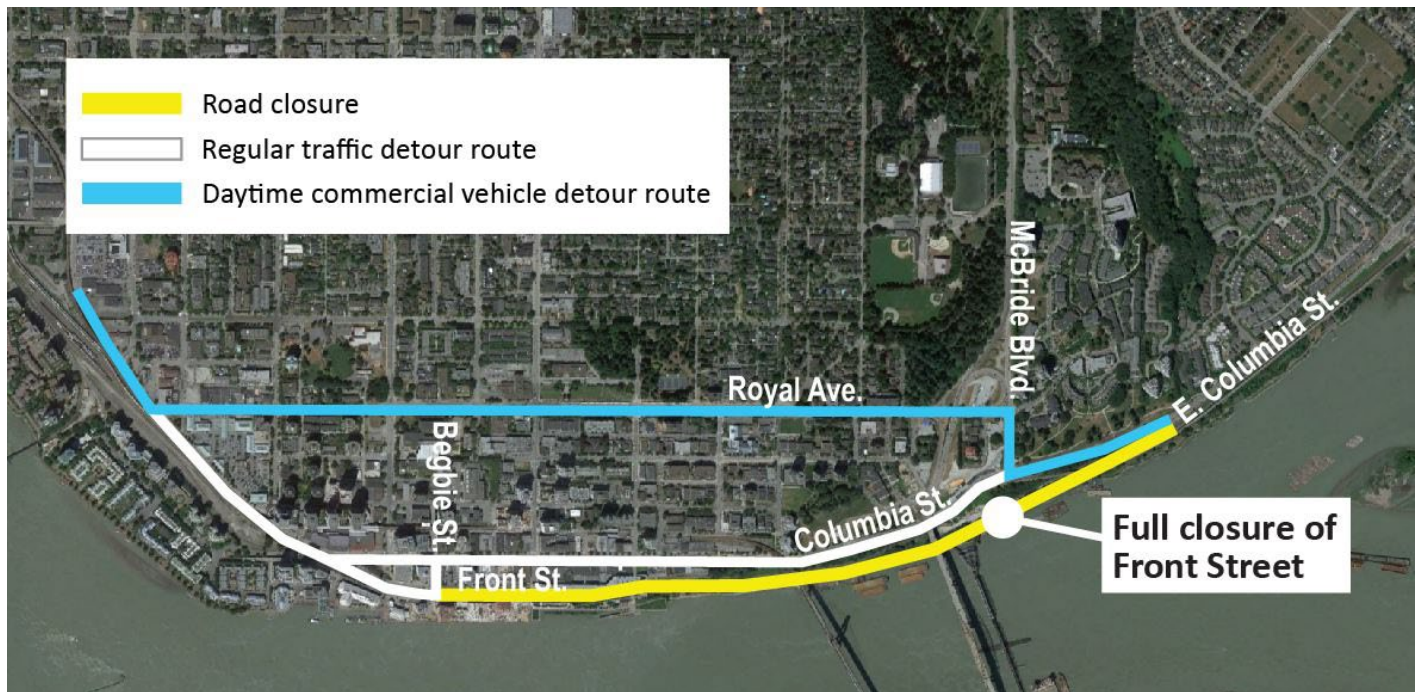
December 10, 2024

Front Street between Begbie Street and E. Columbia Street has been closed since June for crews to build a temporary support tower, install steel girders, build the new bridge deck, and build a new drainage outfall under Front Street.

The Front Street closure will now extend to March 14, 2025, to complete the girder and deck panel installation over Front Street. We appreciate your patience while this work is underway.

**Access to businesses in downtown New Westminster, including on Front Street Mews, is maintained.** Regular traffic will continue to be detoured to Columbia Street and trucks will continue to use official truck routes based on applicable time restrictions, which include Royal Avenue and Braid Street/E 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue during the day and alternate routes at night. All traffic pattern changes and detours will be well signed, and traffic control personnel will be on site.

## What to Expect



### Timing

Started mid-June 2024 and continuing to March 14, 2025



### Hours of Work

Work activities will take place 7 days a week. As much as possible, noisy work activities will be completed during the day.



### Traffic

Regular traffic will be detoured to Columbia Street. Front Street Mews will remain open. Trucks will be detoured to designated truck routes such as Royal Avenue and Braid Street/E 8th Avenue during the day. Alternatively, trucks may use 10th Avenue both day and night. Traffic control personnel will be on site to assist when necessary. All traffic pattern changes and detour routes will be well signed.



### Impacts/Interruptions

Drivers may experience longer than normal travel times due to detours and higher traffic volumes. Nearby residents may hear some noise while girders are bolted into place. We appreciate your patience while this work is underway.
