





Roadwork and temporary no parking on Agnes Street, Dufferin Street, and Hastings Street

January 23, 2025

Starting the week of January 27, Fraser Crossing Partners will be conducting intermittent roadwork on Agnes Street, Dufferin Street, and Hastings Street. In mid-February, crews will then build curbs and pave all three roadways.

While this work is underway, temporary no parking will be in effect along Agnes Street between Dufferin Street and Hastings Street, along Dufferin Street between Royal Avenue and Agnes Street, and on Hastings Street.

Driveway and sidewalk accesses for residents will be maintained, and traffic control personnel will be on-site when required.

Once paving is complete, Dufferin Street at Royal Avenue will be converted to a cul-de-sac. The current pedestrian restriction between Royal Avenue and Dufferin Street remains in effect. Please continue to use Coburg Street as a detour.

Parking on the south side of Agnes Street between Dufferin Street and Hastings Street will be permanently removed due to the reconfiguration of the roadway and overall improvements planned for this area.

7 a.m. – 8 p.m.



Traffic

Access to Dufferin Street and Agnes Street between Coburg Street and Dufferin Street will be open to residents only. Traffic control personnel will be on-site when required.



Impacts/Interruptions

Nearby residents may hear noise from intermittent saw cutting, milling, and other construction activities. Temporary parking restrictions will be in effect 24 hours a day when required.
