

Extended – Temporary restriction of Old Yale Road southbound across Highway 17

January 29, 2025

As part of the Pattullo Bridge Replacement Project, Highway 17 will be grade-separated over Old Yale Road, improving traffic flow on Highway 17. In summer 2024, the eastbound portion of the overpass was opened to traffic.

Construction of the westbound portion will continue in February, and to complete this work, the temporary restriction of Old Yale Road southbound across Highway 17 will remain in effect until early March. More information will be provided in advance of these construction activities.

Timing

Ongoing until early March 2025.



Hours of Work

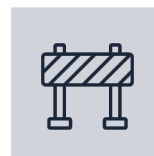
7 a.m. – 10 p.m.

As much as possible, noisy work activities are being completed during the day. Some non-noisy work activities will take place at night and on Sundays.



Traffic

The temporary restriction of Old Yale Road southbound across Highway 17 will remain in effect 24/7. Drivers will be detoured to Tannery Road via Highway 17 westbound. When required, traffic control personnel will be on site and all traffic pattern changes will be well-signed.



Impacts/Interruptions

Drivers may experience longer than normal travel times due to the temporary detours. We appreciate your patience while this work is underway.
