



Nighttime work on Columbia Street between McBride Boulevard and the Pattullo Bridge

February 13, 2025

In January, the majority of deck panels were installed on top of the girders across Columbia Street between McBride Boulevard and the existing bridge to form the new bridge deck. Starting Tuesday, February 18, crews will install the overhang decks and remaining deck panels to complete the outer structure of the bridge deck. This work will continue for approximately three weeks.

Traffic will be maintained in each direction. Nighttime traffic control will be implemented at night between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m.

After the deck panels are complete, additional nighttime closures will be required for concrete pours and other finishing activities for the bridge deck over the next few months. More information will be provided in advance.

What to Expect



Timing

Starting February 18 and continuing for approximately three weeks.



Hours of Work

Work will take place 24 hours per day.

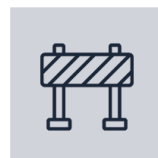
Traffic control will be implemented nightly from 9 p.m. until 5 a.m.

These activities are not anticipated to be noisy.



Traffic

One lane of traffic maintained in each direction. Occasional single lane alternating traffic will be required. Trucks will continue to use official truck routes based on applicable time restrictions, which include Royal Avenue and Braid Street/E 8th Avenue during the day and alternate routes at night. All traffic pattern changes will be well signed.



Impacts/Interruptions

Access for drivers, pedestrians, and cyclists will be maintained.

Occasionally at night, short stoppages will be required for pedestrians and cyclists on the Central Valley Greenway while deck panel lifts are being conducted. Traffic control personnel will be on site to assist.
